## PROBLEM AREAS

Parking issues are a concern for many of us. Street parking with four wheels on the pavement is permitted only during family gatherings. There are other parking violations cited in our Ordinance which will soon be handled internally. Time and date stamped pictures of vehicles in wrong places will be used for enforcement and payment of fines.

## SOLICITATION

We have a non-solicitors ordinance which by law cannot prevent religious organizations or people running for elected office to knock on your door. They can be ignored. You can place a No Solicitation sign by your door. If a person knocks anyway ask for a business card or try to get the persons name and company affiliation. Then call Metro Police 8th District at 502-574-2111 option 8 and make them aware of the problem. Also call or email that info to the city line and the city attorney will contact them.

## REAL ESTATE TAXES

Because of unexpected expenses during the last fiscal year, the City Commission decided to increase the latest tax rate beyond what is normally permitted. For example, the \$35,000 Snow budget was exceeded by \$53,000. The deadline for City property owners to file a tax
